Voting by proxy

The Florida Corporations Not for Profit statute is found in chapter 617, F.S., which outlines the rules community associations must follow with regard to the operation and management of the association. Language was added to section 617.0721, F.S. in 2015, amending the section to allow proxy holders to use a copy, fax transmission or other reliable reproduction of an original proxy for all proper purposes, provided the copy is complete. Members who are entitled to vote may vote in person or by proxy as provided for in the bylaws, articles of incorporation or otherwise and proxies allow many to vote when they may not be present for the meeting. All proxies must be in writing. The amendment is the only found in chapter 617 for 2015.
